Attendant Care:

Ms. Smith requires 24-hour attendant care due to her need for assistance with Hoyer lift transfers, dressing, repositioning in bed, bowel program, incontinence care, and catheterization every three to four hours. (As noted earlier in this report, Ms. Smith's urologist feels that her need for every three- to four-hour catheterization will continue throughout her lifetime.) Ms. Smith also needs assistance for passive range of motion exercises, peritoneal skin care, meal preparation, cleaning, shampooing her hair, grocery shopping, and laundry. Nighttime attendant care is required due to her inability to get out of bed independently and exit her home in case of an emergency. Her attendant care services are being provided by Quality Nurses.

As an alternative to the above, Ms. Smith could potentially be independent when up in her wheelchair in a wheelchair-accessible environment for three-hour time periods during the day. Her need for intermittent catheterization could be met by an aide schedule of 10:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m. (nine hours of nighttime care), an aide visit from 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. with catheterizations at the start and end of the visit, and a second daytime aide visit between 4:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. with catheterization also occurring at the start and end of these visits. The total number of attendant care hours would be 15 hours per day for this routine.
